IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES (CLINTON HEALTH ACCESS INITIATIVE)
ORDER, 2025

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 24 (1) of the Immunities and Privileges Act, I, NANCY TEMBO, Minister of Foreign Affairs, hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Immunities and Privileges (Clinton Health Access Initiative) Order, 2025. Citation

2. The Alliance for a Clinton Health Access Initiative (hereinafter referred to as “CHAI”) being an organization specified in the *Fourth Schedule* of the Act, shall have all the immunities and privileges set out in Part I of the *Fifth Schedule* of the Act and shall have all the legal capacities of a body corporate. Immunities and privileges and legal capacity of CHAI

3. There are hereby conferred upon such persons, not being citizens of, or permanently resident in, Malawi, as CHAI may, in writing, to the Minister of Foreign Affairs designate by name being— Immunities and privileges of representatives and staff of CHAI

(a) representatives of CHAI or holders of such high offices of CHAI as shall be specified in such writing, all the immunities and privileges set out in Part II of the *Fifth Schedule* of the Act; and

(b) officers or servants of CHAI of such class as shall be specified in such writing, all the immunities and privileges set out in Part III of the *Fifth Schedule* of the Act.

EMPLOYMENT (MINIMUM WAGES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2025

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 54 of the Employment Act, I, PETER DIMBA, Minister of Labour, in consultation with the relevant organisations of employers and employees, make the following Order—

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment (Minimum Wages) (Amendment) Order, 2025 and shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 2025.

Amendment to Cap. 55:01 Sub.leg. p.34

2. The Employment (Minimum Wages) Order (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Order”) is amended, in paragraph 2 (1) by—

(a) deleting the figure “K3,461.54” in subparagraph (a) and substituting therefor, the figure “K4,846.16”; and

(b) deleting the figure “K3,461.54” in subparagraph (b) and substituting therefor, the figure “K4,846.16”.

Amendment of para. 3 of the principal Order

3. The principal Order is amended, in paragraph 3, by deleting the figure “K2,000.00” and substituting therefor the figure “K2,800.00”.

Amendment of para. 4 of the principal Order

4. The principal Order is amended, in paragraph 4, by—

(a) deleting the figure “K2,884.62” in subparagraph (a) and substituting therefor, the figure “K4,038.47”; and

(b) deleting the figure “K3,461.54” in subparagraph (b) and substituting therefor, the figure “K4,846.16”; and

(c) inserting subparagraph (c) immediately after paragraph (b) as follows—

“(c) K5,769.23 per day, in case of employee employed in a shop.”.
